



GRANT OPPORTUNITIES



RESOURCES FOR NEW AND EXISTING BUSINESSES



Commercial Lease Assistance Program (SBS)

- Free legal assistance on issues regarding new commercial leases, and addressing issues with leases.

NYC LMI Storefront Loan (SBS)

- Applications are closed but can be updated. Loan for improvements to business and storefront up to \$100,000.

Interest Rate Reduction Grant (SBS)

- Can be used on interest from loans from select Community Development Financial Institutions (CDFIs)
- Grant to free up cash flow to help maintain operations

Neighborhood Business Grants -

Citizens Committee for New York City

- Small Businesses experiencing financial distress due to Covid-19. Grant amounts of up to 10K.

All in Neighborhood Grants - Citizens Committee for New York City

- Micro Grants for resident led grants to address community sensitive issues. Grant amounts up to 10K.

NYC Business Solutions

- Financing for under-served minority and immigrant entrepreneurs and low-income small business owners to increase financial stability and foster economic growth that will create jobs in Brooklyn. Micro loans between \$500 - \$10,000.

Paycheck Protection Program

- A forgivable loan designed to provide direct incentive for small businesses to keep their workers on the payroll. Open until May 31, 2021.

New York Community Trust

- Nonprofit organizations who are interested in funding from NYT can submit a letter of interest for the project their interested in funding.

Brooklyn Alliance Capital - Brooklyn Chamber of Commerce

- Financing for under-served minority and immigrant entrepreneurs and low-income small business owners to increase financial stability and foster economic growth that will create jobs in Brooklyn. Micro loans between \$500 - \$10,000.

Business Adaptation Playbook Workshop

- Small business services is hosting a multi-session workshop to help entrepreneurs stabilize their businesses. The workshop sessions are free and open to any business owners or entrepreneurs.

Reduce Operating Expenses

- Free consultation from a representative from SBS on how to reduce operating expenses. Program ideas include energy savings, commercial expansion, relocation and employment assistance program, etc.

Immigrant Business Services

- This guide offers a step-by-step advice for immigrant entrepreneurs in their small business needs. Topics include signing a commercial lease, navigating government, and understanding the rights of immigrant New Yorkers.

Brownsville Gateway CBEDC Incubator

- An opportunity designed to support Brownsville residents create businesses and nonprofit organizations.
